The problem of gutters clogging with debris has been around as long as, well, as long as gutters have been around. Cleaning out dirty gutters has been the dangerous and time consuming task of countless homeowners ever since. There have been many attempts at solving this problem, especially in recent years. In today's fast paced society few homeowners want to deal with the recurring task of cleaning their gutters.

The traditional method of attempting to deal with this problem has been the use of gutter screens. Unfortunately, these screens rarely solved the problem of clogged gutters and sometimes even caused additional problems. Screens would often collapse and move out of place. The screens themselves would often become clogged and water would run right over the gutters.

In recent years other solutions to keeping gutters free of debris have become popular. One of these solutions has been the reverse curve, which works on the principle of water adhesion. This concept uses an aluminum cover with a reverse curve at the edge of the gutter, which allows the water to flow into the gutter while allowing the debris to fall over the edge of the gutter onto the ground. Although this concept has been around for over one hundred years it has only recently become popular. In spite of the numerous designs based on this concept it has not proved a total success. In heavy rains this type of gutter protection tends to overflow and sometimes the leaves will flow around the curve and still find their way into the gutter.

Another attempted solution has been to go back and make



improvements to the gutter screen. The resulting products tend to be better than the old fashioned type of screen, but have still not solved all the inherent problems of using a screen. Some have tried making screens out of heavier materials. This has solved the problems of the screens collapsing, but they still tend to become clogged with debris and sometimes they still allow too much trash into the gutter. Others have tried to make screens out of a super fine stainless steel weave. They often boast about not letting anything into the gutter. Although this claim tends to be true, these types of screening materials will tend to become clogged with fine dirt and tree sap, allowing water to run over the top of the gutter.

The solution is to combine the strengths of these systems and eliminate the weaknesses. RAINTRAP® Gutter Protection is the answer to this dilemma.
